Established as the State Film Centre in the 1960s, the theatre underwent an architect-led refurbishment in 2015. Its state-of-the-art audio visual systems and elegant heritage features are sure to impress.

The venue is conveniently located in central Melbourne – near Treasury Gardens, on the corner of Spring Street and Macarthur Street in East Melbourne.

Auditorium

Our theatre boasts a raised stage, tiered seating and two dedicated wheelchair spaces, guaranteeing unobstructed views for every guest. The dedicated audio visual control room offers top-of-the-line equipment. Convenient pre-set features deliver professional-quality lighting, sound, filming, and seamless presentations at the touch of a button. Our state-of-the-art hearing augmentation system delivers crystal clear audio to hearing aid devices.


Food and beverage preparation space

A purpose-built food preparation space is available, equipped with fridges, dishwashers, storage, and ample bench space to meet your catering needs. A discrete kiosk window provides convenient access to the function space. Onsite storage is also available.

Accessibility



Audio Loop

The auditorium is equipped with audio loop technology, delivering crystal-clear sound directly to hearing aids and assistive listening devices.

Wheelchairs

A dedicated bathroom is available. The auditorium has two dedicated spaces for wheelchairs. A wheelchair lift provides access to the auditorium. Lift platform dimensions: 110cm x 84cm.

An accessible pathway to the venue is available via Spring Street.

Monday to Friday - 8am to 11pm

Saturdays, Sundays, and public holidays - 8am to 6pm.

Getting there

Stairs lead from the Upper Plaza at street level of 1 Macarthur Street down to the theatre. It is also possible to access the theatre via Spring Street and Treasury Place. (See the accessible pathway map).

Train


The theatre is conveniently located near both the Spring Street exit and Macarthur Street exit of Parliament Station.

Trams

The free City Circle tram and tram routes 11, 12 and 109 stop at the intersection of Spring Street and Collins Street.

Parking

On-street paid parking and paid car parks are available within walking distance, such as Wilson Parking at the Park Hyatt Hotel and also at Collins Place.



FAQs

Can I visit the venue?

One-hour bookings can be arranged in advance, for venue inspections or to test equipment. Please email treasurytheatre@dtf.vic.gov.au to arrange a time.

What technical support is available?

Event organisers will be provided with a guide on how to use the theatre's audio-visual system on confirmation of booking. Event organisers who would like help running the equipment may hire a technician at a cost. We recommend MAV, 03 9429 2058, <https://mav.com.au/about/>.

What are the catering arrangements?

Event organisers are responsible for organising catering services for their event. Caterer access to the theatre is possible by prior arrangement. Glassware, crockery, and cutlery to be arranged by the event organiser and removed at the conclusion of the event hire.

How can I change or cancel my booking?

Cancelling or changing hours must be done in writing to treasurytheatre@dtf.vic.gov.au. Bookings may be cancelled up to four (4) business days prior to the event without charge. We reserve the right to cancel a booking without charge for hazardous, health, or legal reasons or if a senior Victorian Government official requires the theatre for a briefing or media conference. Event organisers will receive notification of cancellation.

How can I access the venue?

The Security office, located to the right of the theatre entrance, will provide the event organiser with an access pass at the start of the booking.

Can deliveries be made to the venue?

Yes. Event organisers are required to provide the relevant company's contact information, including driver's name, vehicle registration number, delivery, and pickup times at least seven (7) days prior to the event. These details should be sent to treasurytheatre@dtf.vic.gov.au.

What are the cleaning arrangements?

Hospitality areas must be cleaned of all rubbish and restored to their original state after use. Event organisers will incur a cleaning fee if the venue is not left in a clean state immediately after the event. Also, please be aware that theatre management strictly prohibits taking food or beverages inside the auditorium.
